The Eastland Fire Department is combination fire department with staff working a 24/48 shift schedule. We are responsible for providing fire and rescue services within the city of Eastland and approximately 294 square miles of rural Eastland County, including a 9-mile corridor of Interstate I-20. The Eastland Fire Department responded to 870 incidents in 2023. We provide BLS first responder assistance to the hospital-based EMS transport system.
