Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma / GED
- Valid Texas Driver's License
- *Applicant must be insurable and able to obtain Class B license within 30 Days of Hire*
- *Current TCFP Firefighter Basic or Higher (verifiable online) at time of appointment
- *Current TDSHS EMT-B or Higher (verifiable online) at time of appointment
- No unacceptable criminal or driving histories will be permitted for consideration
- Applicant must be able to physically perform job duties as assigned

Employee Benefits:

- Health Insurance (Employee 100% / Family Available at Employee Expense)
- Dental & Vision Insurance (Employee 100% / Family Available at Employee Expense)
- Life Insurance (Employee 100%)
- Retirement Plan through TCDRS with 10 year vesting
- 10 Days of Vacation Accrued per Year based on number of hours worked

- 24 / 48 Hour Schedule

Pay Schedule:

- Apprentice Fire Rescue Officer (first six months): \$10.16 per hour - Approximately \$30,881 per year

- Fire Rescue Officer 2: (after two years) \$13.70 per hour - Approximately \$41,641.15 per year
- EMT-I Pay: \$2,000 per year
- Longevity: After two years employment, scaled annually over 10 years for a maximum of \$8,300.00
