The Curriculum and Testing Committee is seeking applications for the Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting Ad-Hoc Committee. There is one vacancy on the committee.

The committee meets, on average, four times during an update, at commission headquarters in Austin. Committee members are not reimbursed by TCFP for any travel expenses. Committee members will be actively involved in intense review and development of ARFF training curriculum. Meetings typically last two to three days. Committees may also meet virtually, as needed.

Applicants must hold, at a minimum, Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighter, Instructor I, and experience in teaching of ARFF courses preferred.
