TCFP Structural Firefighter Texas DSHS EMT-B or higher Strong organizational skills Familiarity with fire codes (IFC as required by AHJ, and NFPA) If not inspector certified, will have one year to complete TCFP approved course and certify. **Preferred:** TCFP Fire Inspector Fire Officer 1

Duties:

Management of Field ID System, assignment of daily inspections to ERTs, review of inspections for discrepancies in database, training of ERTs on usage of scanners, compiling of reports for internal use, communication with TMNA on program and inspections.

Fire Safety Audits:

Scheduling and performance of audits throughout shops for fire safety, contact of shop management and Safety for resolving issues. Perform and supervise random audits on hot works throughout the plant.

Code Compliance:

Serve as reference for IFC and NFPA codes, review submitted building plans for possible violations. Inspect ongoing construction projects to ensure code compliance.

FM Global:

Serve as liaison between department and FM Global for plan review. Maintain familiarity with applicable FM Global data sheets. Prepare reports and present to FM Global staff during annual audit. Serve as facilitator for FM Global plant visits.

APPLICANTS MAY BE REJECTED FOR EMPLOYMENT AT ANY POINT IN THE HIRING PROCESS. Any misrepresentation or omission in the application or other forms will be grounds for rejection or dismissal.

An applicant is unacceptable if;

O Dishonorably discharged from the military
