Please read this section carefully:

A written test, physical agility, and interview process will be the first steps for those individuals selected to move on and will be scheduled according to applicant response. A criminal history check and a driver's license check will be completed afterwards before conditional employment will be offered. Applicants must meet current city policy in regard to criminal history and driver's license requirements. All process dates and times shall be posted to all applicants that advance. **Applications must be in to BHFD by June 30, 2023, by 5 PM. Test date TBD.**

Employment Steps:

1. Application form with all required documents, incomplete applications will be removed from consideration.
2. Certification Verification
3. Written Test
4. Physical Ability Test
5. Oral Interview Panel
6. Driver's license and criminal history check
7. Conditional Job Offer
8. Physical Exam and Drug Test

Minimum Qualifications requirements:

- High School diploma or equivalent
- Texas Commission on Fire Protection-Basic Structural Certified Firefighter
- Texas Department of State Health Services EMT-Basic
- The ability to be covered under the city's vehicle insurance policy and the ability to obtain a Class B Exempt license.
