### **HIRING PROCESS:**

- 1. Apply online in our career page in our website

  \*\*Deadline is July 22 by 5:00 PM CST
- 2. Take written test, Saturday, July 27, 2024 Must have a passing score of 75%

No admittance after 8:00 am and confirmation of testing and a valid picture ID is required

4. Physical agility test (PAT), Saturday, July 27, 2024

The PAT (performed in a helmet, gloves and air pack - not breathing air) consists of:

- Dragging a charged 1/2" hose line 50 feet
- Pulling a 90lb sled 50 feet while staying with a 3' x 3' box
- Dragging a 165 lb. rescue Randy 50 feet
- Placing 6-50 lb. bags from an elevated platform to the ground and back
- Climbing a 5 ft. elevated platform
- Raising a 1 ¾' hose line 50 ft. hand-over-hand with a utility rope
- Descending from a 50 ft. elevated platform
- Keiser sled
- 3. Oral interview boards, Monday, July 29, 2024

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Must be 18 years or older, have a H.S. Diploma or GED at the time of application
- License/Certification
- A current, valid Texas driver's license is required
- TCFP Structural Firefighter basic certification required
- TCFP Marine Firefighter basic certifications required within 3 months of hire
- TCFP Hazardous Materials Technician certification required within 1 year of hire
- TCFP Driver Operator certification required within
   1 year of hire

- TDSHS Emergency Medical Technician basic required
- NIMS IS 100, 200, 700, 800 required
- A Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) must be obtained within 30 days of appointment, and be maintained for the duration of employment
- Possess a valid Texas driver's license with an acceptable driving record
- Applicants outside the State of Texas must be eligible for certification through TCFP and TDSHS.
